

**RE: Recent Election Developments**

Dear Congresswoman Beutler,

This correspondence is from the Yakima County Farm Bureau (YCFB). YCFB is a grass roots organization with 2700 members consisting of farmers and ranchers with operations both large and small as well as other folks with interest in agriculture affairs in Yakima <u>and Klickitat</u> <u>Counties.</u>

The Yakima County Farm Bureau believes that the Presidential election was stolen from President Donald Trump. We believe that a sweeping effort was implemented in certain States (commonly referred to as Swing States) that subverted the will of the American people which reversed the outcome. We also believe it must be corrected.

The YCFB believes that if this fraudulent election result stands that "2020" will become the template in future elections and just like Mexico where one party owned the Presidency ...... for seventy years, America will follow a similar path.
